4. **Kindly Note:** Each student is required to choose one Core subject and one Graded subject of their preference. The subject teacher will assign topics related to these subjects to each student and it will be informed through class teacher by **Thursday, 9<sup>th</sup> May 2024.**
5. All projects should be submitted by **Tuesday, 4<sup>th</sup> June 2024.**
6. Best Projects from each category will be awarded by the School Managing Committee and the students will also be given academic points.
